**2001 Quintessa** “Bright red-ruby...musky, rather exotic aromas of dark raspberry, blackberry, wood smoke and spicy oak, complicated by a mineral pungency...fat, sweet and lush, with deep flavors of dark berries and truffle. At once classically dry and pliant, with a fatter texture than most past releases of this wine. The finish features big, broad, dusty tannins; good building length; and a note of Rutherford dust. **91 points**”

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
